Dear Alumni and Friends:

Welcome to the fall newsletter of the UK Department of Mathematics. I want express my gratitude to **Peter Perry**, who served as Interim Chair, and thank him for his excellent leadership

Last year, we resumed our traditional special lecture series. Emily Riehl from Johns Hopkins University delivered the **Hayden-Howard Lecture**. We were fortunate to have two speakers giving **Eaves Lectures**, Henry Segerman from the University of Oklahoma in the fall of 2022 and Alissa Crans from Loyola Marymount University last spring.

Many of you attended our **Alumni Day** on April 7. Our former doctoral students, David Cook, Jiyoon Jung, and Daphne Skipper, delivered exciting lectures on their career paths. In addition, our alum Mark Motley (Ph.D. 2002) talked on Post-Quantum Cryptography last fall. Additionally, the departmental **Spectra** student chapter hosted the national Spectra Survey of Mathematics Conference 2023 this past May.

We are fortunate to have many outstanding students and faculty who excel in teaching, research, and service. Five faculty were recognized by the College of Arts and Sciences Faculty and received Awards: **Katherine Paullin** (Peer Mentoring), **Bertrand Guillou** (Outstanding Teaching), **Bradley Elliott** (Outstanding Teaching), **Chloe Wawrzyniak** (Promotion of Diversity or Inclusion), **Christopher Manon** (Outstanding Undergraduate Research Mentoring). Furthermore, three graduate students were honored for their outstanding teaching: Angela Hansen (Provost Award), Kaitlin Bruegge (A&S Award), and Lewis Dominguez (A&S Award).

Effective July 1, 2023, **Kate Ponto** was promoted to full professor. **Nat Stapleon** and **Xuancheng Shao** were selected for three-year appointments as Edwards Research Professor and Royster Research Professor, respectively. In his third year at UK, **Duc Nguyen** received his third NSF grant to support his research.

In May and August 2023, twelve students graduated with a Ph.D. We are proud that all of them obtained a high-quality position in academia, industry, or government.






The Department of Mathematics is hosting the **Ohio River Analysis Meeting** (**ORAM 13**) at the University of Kentucky March 16-17, 2024.






The spring **J.C. Eaves Lecture** featured Dr. Alissa Crans from Loyola Marymount University. **Read more.**


