**Course:** We will begin with Chapter 12 and proceed through Chapter 16 omitting some sections. There will be two (2) **EVENING** Semester examinations and a Final examination. The two evening Semester exams will be at 7:00 pm on February 29 and April 16. The Final Examination is Monday, April 30, at 1:00 pm

**Grades:** Each semester examination will be worth 100 points and the Final will be 200. In addition there is homework of three types:

1. Online homework using WebWork – Password is last 8 digits of your student number (<http://webwork2.ms.uky.edu/webwork2>. Click on ma213\_0102) - will be assigned and due roughly three times a week (TWF) and will be worth 50 points of your final grade. Late homework **will not be accepted**. Contact Dr. Cox in case of an emergency or illness. A scheduled absence (travel or authorized UK activity) does not exempt you.
2. Class assigned problems (usually one per class) from the text to be handed in the next Thursday at your recitation section. One or two of these will be graded each week. Your lowest two scores will be dropped and the rest will be worth 50 points. Late assignments will not be accepted except for documented excuses.
3. Class assigned problems that will not be collected but may appear on exams.
