## RESEARCH

- Computing Integral homology, Effective Algebraic  $K$ -theory, and Very Effective Hermitian  $K$ -theory of geometric classifying spaces  $BC_{2^n}$  ( $n > 1$ ) using motivic Adams and Atiyah–Hirzebruch spectral sequences over  $\mathbb{C}$  and  $\mathbb{R}$  (manuscript in preparation).
- Extending these calculations to finite fields  $\mathbb{F}_q$  for  $q \equiv 1, 3 \pmod{4}$ .
- Analysing multiplicative structures, hidden extensions, and higher operations arising in these spectral sequences, with emphasis on comparisons between classical and motivic settings.
- Explored the  $C_2$ -equivariant Adams spectral sequence converging to  $RO(C_2)$ -graded homotopy groups of  $ko^{C_2}$ , and its connection with  $\mathbb{R}$ -motivic homotopy theory, with plans to extend these computations in the  $C_2$ -equivariant setting.
